#### **2025 BUDGET**

Please find enclosed a copy of the 2025 Budget as approved by the Board of Directors. The enclosed Budget includes the 2024 monthly Budget, the 2025 monthly Budget and the 2025 annual Budget.

#### **HOA PAYMENTS**

Monthly assessments payments are due on the 1st of every month. If you are enrolled in the ACH (auto-debit program), you will need to log into your account through ClickPay to adjust your monthly payment amount starting with your January 1, 2025 payment.

The ClickPay site is available at:

https://login.clickpay.com/cmi/

However, users that utilize the "full amount" setting will have their autopay automatically updated.

If you have your autopay date selected for a date that is after the 1st of the month and you receive a late fee due to the time required for payment processing, you will not have this fee waived. The grace period is available to allow payments submitted on the 1st of the month to be fully processed and credit to the owner's
